In response to the Coronavirus, the following information has been compiled from each School Districts website as of 3/23/20.

List of School Districts Plans for Free/Reduced Breakfast/Lunch

East Ramapo School District

The East Ramapo School District will offer a “Pack and Pickup” breakfast and lunch between 8:00 a.m. -10:00 am for the District’s students who currently participate in the free and reduced-price lunch program. Breakfast and lunch may be picked up together, one time per day, at any of the below locations. In addition, for those students who do not have access to technology, handouts listing educational activities will be available at the locations.

At each location, there will be a parked school bus with a table outside of the bus. A family member may pick up food and take it home to the student. Any individual picking up food will be required to sign a form. There will be no charge for the food. Anyone who is in self-quarantine may not visit any of the location.

Haverstraw Stony Point School District

The North Rockland Central School District will have four different locations throughout the school community for daily meal distribution. Families can pick up meals at any of the four designated locations. The buildings for meal distribution are James A. Farley Elementary School (Stony Point), Haverstraw Elementary School (Village of Haverstraw), North Rockland High School (Thiells) and West Haverstraw Elementary School (Village of West Haverstraw). These meal distribution locations will be open Monday through Friday between 10:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. During these times, bagged meals including lunch for that day and breakfast for the following morning will be available for pickup in the front of the building.

Pearl River School District

Students who currently receive free/reduced lunch can pick up a bagged breakfast and lunch at Pearl River High School Pirate Cove between the hours of 11:30 AM and 12:30 PM, Monday through Friday. If you have any questions about eligibility, please contact brunnerj@pearlriver.org.

Suffern School District

Our food service provider Aramark and Chestnut Ridge Transportation have worked out a system to deliver to students who utilize our free and reduced lunch program. Nanuet School District



To all families of students that receive free and reduced meal benefits:

This is to inform you that the Nanuet Union Free Central School District will be providing breakfast and lunch meals for your children during this current school closure. **This will begin Thursday, March 19th at 10 am.** For the convenience of our families, on Mondays, Tuesdays and Thursdays, students will receive two days of breakfast and lunch.

Below is the schedule:

Days: MONDAY, TUESDAY & THURSDAY

Location: Nanuet High School Drop Off in Front of Building

Hours: Between 10 am – NOON only

Meals: On Monday, you will receive 1 Breakfast Meal and 1 Lunch Meal.

On Tuesday and Thursday, you will receive 2 Breakfasts and 2 Lunches

Rockland BOCES

For Rockland BOCES and out-of-district students who regularly receive breakfast and lunch on a typical school day, please visit the website of your *home school district* for specific information on meal access and distribution locations. Rockland BOCES will provide to each district a list of students eligible for free and reduced meals.

Nyack School District

Students who currently receive free/reduced lunch will be able to pick up a bagged breakfast and lunch at the Nyack Center, Monday through Friday from 9:30 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. **or** at Waldron Terrace Parking Lot (via mobile unit on parking lot of housing complex), Monday through Friday from 10:00 – 11:00 a.m., available will school is closed.

Clarkstown School District

The Clarkstown Central School District will be offering free “Grab and Go” bagged meals from 7:00 am to 1:00 pm, Monday through Friday, at the Felix Festa Middle School, we will provide curbside meal pick up at the Student Drop Off lane located at the Parrot Road entrance to the school. On Fridays, we will also provide additional food provisions for the weekend.

South Orangetown School District

The South Orangetown Central School District will provide free “grab-and-go” breakfast and lunch for students, 18 years old or younger. This food service will be available Monday through Friday, 9:00AM-12:00PM. Meals will be distributed via a walk-up kiosk located at the side door of the South Orangetown Middle School Cafeteria, at the rear of the Erie Street parking lot.

Please keep in mind that there are a limited number of meals available each day and will be distributed on a first-come, first-served basis.

Home delivery is available for those unable to travel to the SOMS Cafeteria distribution site. One week’s worth of breakfast and lunch will be delivered on Mondays only, between 9:00-11:00AM.
