ACTION: Chair Soskin requested from Health Department: what health plan are available to people covered by Medicaid?

Deputy Health Commissioner Ron Hansen stated that the DOH, because of the Affordable Care Act, has been awarded a continuation IPA/Navigator grant from the New York State Department of Health to reach uninsured Children, adults and small business employers. At this time the department staff includes 2 Creole Haitian-speaking and 1 Spanish-speaking employees. October through April of they had submitted about 3,300 applications. It has now increased to 4,400. November 15th open enrollments begins again and they are expecting at least 4,000 new applicants.

Chair Soskin asked how many insurance companies do they have participating as providers?

Mr. Hansen answered about 2/3 of the insurance companies enroll in Medicaid.

Deputy County Clerk Joseph Alongi stated that this grant funding would be used to digitize 181,000 discharges of mortgages and payroll earning records that currently exist in hard copy. He also added that this would come at low expense to the county.

Chair Soskin expressed his concerned about payroll records being kept confidential and not being available for public view.

Mr. Alongi confirmed that by policy all payroll records are indeed kept confidential.

Chair Soskin asked how far back do these records go?

Mr. Alongi replied that payroll earning records would cover the years 1985 to 1999 which totals 9,200 employee files.

We have approx 600-700 latent TB cases.

(Persons with latent TB infection do not feel sick and do not have any symptoms. They are infected with M. tuberculosis, but do not have TB disease. Persons with latent TB infection are not infectious and cannot spread TB infection to others.)

All children who enter school have 60 days to produce proof of all required vaccines. This included unemancipated children, which East Ramapo received 50 recently.
