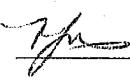

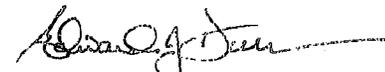

WHEREAS, The Budget and Finance Committee of this Legislature has met, considered and approved this resolution, however, it was approved within 120 hours of the full legislative meeting and was deemed an immediate need by its Chair, now therefore be, be it

RESOLVED, That the 2013 rates, rentals, fees or other charges for the use or availability of the Rockland County Solid Waste Management Authority's facilities and services, as set forth on the attached schedule, shall be included in the County warrant, imposed upon each parcel of land as the Authority has determined, and shall be collected in the several towns within Rockland County in the same manner as other County charges, and shall be paid to the Commissioner of Finance.
