

**LOCAL LAW NO. 7 OF 2011
COUNTY OF ROCKLAND
STATE OF NEW YORK**

Mr. Schoenberger offered the following Local Law, which was seconded by Mr. Grant and adopted:

A local law overriding tax levy limit for fiscal year 2012 in the county of Rockland.

Be it enacted by the legislature of the county of Rockland as follows:

Section 1. Overriding Tax Levy Limit for 2012.

For fiscal year 2012, the county of Rockland overrides the real property tax levy limit established by Chapter 97 of the Laws of 2011 of the state of New York, and may adopt a budget for fiscal year 2012 that requires a tax levy that is greater than such tax levy limit.

Section 2. Effective date.

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the office of the secretary of state pursuant to section 27 of the municipal home law rule.
