PUBLIC HEALTH NURSES (PREVENTIVE HEALTH & HOSPICE PROGRAM)

The Oswego County Health Department has immediate openings for two full-time public health nurses to work in preventive health and the hospice program. The preventive health division nurse will provide skilled nursing care to at-risk pregnant women and children in their home and will work in prevention programs related to immunization, communicable disease, tuberculosis, and lead poisoning. The hospice nurse is an integral part of the interdisciplinary team providing comprehensive end of life care to residents of Oswego County.

Qualifications: Bachelor's degree in nursing and one (1) year of professional acute care nursing experience and possession of a current valid license and registration to practice as a Registered Professional Nurse in NYS. Pay rate is \$24.27/hour plus competitive benefit package.
