



CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICER

- A. Graduation from a regionally accredited or NYS registered two-year college with an Associate's Degree or higher in Construction Technology, Civil Engineering or a closely related field with similar course curriculum, and two (2) years of full-time paid experience, or its part-time paid equivalent, in the design, construction or inspection of buildings as a project manager, estimator, construction superintendent or general contractor, or in municipal building code enforcement activities;

OR

- B. Graduation from high school or possession of a high school equivalency diploma and five (5) years of full-time paid experience or its part-time paid equivalent, in the design, construction or inspection of buildings as a project manager, estimator, construction superintendent or general contractor, or in municipal building code enforcement activities;

OR

- C. An equivalent combination of training and experience as defined by the limits of (A) and (B).

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:

Possession of a valid New York State Class D driver license at the time of appointment and maintenance of said license for the duration of employment.

Possession of a New York State Code Enforcement Official Certification at time of appointment and maintenance of said certification for the duration of employment.
