Mr. Grant offered the following amended resolution, which was seconded by Mrs. Low-Hogan and unanimously adopted

WHEREAS, The Legislature has heretofore appropriated Seven Hundred Thirty Four Million, Five Hundred Sixty Seven Thousand, Fifty Six Dollars (\$734,567,056) for the general operation of the County of Rockland, and

WHEREAS, Making the sum of One Hundred Eighteen Million, Six Hundred Twenty Nine Thousand, Ten dollars (\$118,629,010) to be raised by property taxes, and

WHEREAS, The Budget & Finance Committee of the Legislature has met, considered and by a unanimous vote approved this resolution, however, it was approved within 120 hours of the full legislative meeting and was deemed an immediate need by its Chair, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the sum of One Hundred Eighteen Million, Six Hundred Twenty Nine Thousand, Ten dollars (\$118,629,010) is hereby levied upon the taxable property in the County of Rockland to be collected in the towns as follows:

RESOLVED, notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in the schedules attached hereto or elsewhere, there shall be no separate entry identifying any portion of the County tax levy as a "NYS Medicaid Tax" or similar; rather, any such entry shall be consolidated with the County property tax into a single entry entitled "County Property Tax," and shall be reflected as such on all tax bills levying County real property taxes, and all calculations related thereto shall be recomputed in accordance herewith; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Chairman of the Legislature and/or the Clerk to the Legislature be and they are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to notify each Town of its share of the 2016 County Budget by issuing a certificate thereof.

WHEREAS, Article 3 of Local Law No. 19 of 1997 entitled "Charges", has been adopted and duly filed with the Secretary of State, and

WHEREAS, Such law provides for the establishment of a sewer rent based upon a per unit charge for property within the boundary of Rockland County Sewer District No. 1, and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Local Law No. 19 of 1997 as authorized by Section 266 of the County Law, sewer rents shall become due and payable at the same time and in the same manner as other County charges; sewer rents shall be imposed upon each parcel of land in accordance with such local law, and shall be collected in the several towns within Rockland County Sewer District No. 1, and from Out-of-District Users in the same manner as other County charges and shall be paid to the Commissioner of Finance, pursuant to the provisions of such Local Law No. 19 of 1997.

WHEREAS, This Legislature has adopted a Sewer Rent based upon an annual Unit charge of \$302.00 (\$342.00 - Spring Valley), (\$352.00 - New Square) and (\$319.00 – Western Ramapo) for the year 2016, and

WHEREAS, The Budget and Finance Committee of the Legislature has met, considered and by a unanimous vote approved this resolution, however, it was approved within 120 hours of the full legislative meeting and was deemed an immediate need by its Chair, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That pursuant to Local Law No. 19 of 1997, sewer rents for the year 2016 shall be due and payable at the same time and in the same manner as other County charges and 2016 sewer rents shall be imposed upon each parcel of land in accordance with such local law and shall be collected in the several towns within the Rockland County Sewer District No. 1 and from out-of-district users and shall be paid to the Commissioner of Finance.
