

**LOCAL LAW NO. 3 OF 2010  
COUNTY OF ROCKLAND  
STATE OF NEW YORK**

Mr. Schoenberger offered the following Local Law, which was seconded by Mr. Murphy and adopted:

A local law providing for the salary of a certain county officer of the county of Rockland.

Be it enacted by the legislature of the county of Rockland as follows:

Section 1.

Notwithstanding any previous local laws or resolutions, the annual salary of the hereinafter designated county officer is hereby fixed at the following amounts to be paid effective January 1, 2008:

Section 2.

Effective January 1, 2009, the above referenced officer shall receive his respective salary as of December 31, 2008 plus a salary increase of two percent (2.0%).

Section 3.

Effective July 1, 2009, the above referenced officer shall receive his respective salary as of June 30, 2009 plus a salary increase of two percent (2.0%).

Section 4.

Effective January 1, 2010, the above referenced officer shall receive his respective salary as of December 31, 2009 plus a salary increase of two percent (2.0%).

Section 5.

Effective July 1, 2010, the above referenced officer shall receive his respective salary as of June 30, 2010 plus a salary increase of two percent (2.0%).

Section 6.

All local laws and resolutions of the legislature of Rockland county or the former board of supervisors of Rockland county, to the extent that the same are inconsistent with this law, are hereby superseded by this law.

Section 7.

Nothing contained herein shall prohibit the legislature from fixing a different salary for prospective appointees for the positions set forth in this local law at the time of such appointment.

Section 8.

This local law is adopted subject to a permissive referendum and the clerk is directed to publish notice of same as required by law.

Section 9.

This local law shall take effect immediately upon its approval by referendum or otherwise as provided by law.
