REF. #9252 - APPROVING ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$5,500,000 (NCTD) FROM THE NEW YORK STATE DIVISION OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY SERVICES (DHSES) THROUGH ITS OFFICE OF INTEROPERABLE AND EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS (OIEC) STATEWIDE INTEROPERABLE COMMUNICATIONS GRANT (#WM12198335) FOR A TWELVE (12) MONTH PERIOD FROM THE EXECUTION OF THE CONTRACT, WITH RENEWALS FOR A PERIOD OF UP TO TWO (2) YEARS BEING AVAILABLE AT THE STATE'S DISCRETION, SUBJECT TO AN APPROPRIATION AND USING \$1,800,000 OF SAID GRANT TOWARD REIMBURSING VARIOUS EXPENSES PREVIOUSLY BUDGETED AND INCURRED WITHIN CAPITAL PROJECT NO. 1860 (R.C.
