Sheriff Falco said budgets are in line and overtime costs are in check. With the sale of the hospital, health professionals that are utilized will be lost and that will affect the corrections department.

Legislators Hood and Carey asked about overtime and personnel.

Sheriff Falco said officers are retiring and new officers are being hired. The new list of candidates is being prepared for future hires.

Chair Hood asked about the Sheriff's outlook for next year.

The Sheriff said the Civil Division activity has soared so additional personnel are needed.

The mounted unit will need to be housed in another location. United Water has offered a free parcel for use and that is being explored.

Legislator Wolfe asked about using county property for that.

Sheriff Falco said parkland would need to be replaced with new parkland if it is used for mounted units.
