## Legislator Paul Recognizes Contributions of June Molof, Director of County Office for the Aging

New City, NY (May 21, 2015) – Rockland County Legislator Aney Paul presented June Molof, the Director of the County's Office for Aging (OFA) with a Distinguished Service Award in recognition of over four decades of advocacy for senior citizens. The presentation took place prior to the recent meeting of the County Legislature.

Mrs. Molof was appointed the Assistant Director of the Office for Aging when it first opened in 1975 and in 1993 became the Director. The OFA assists senior citizens to remain as independent as possible through a network of public and private programs and services, which support older adults and their families. Under Ms. Molof's leadership, the office now serves over 59,000 people in Rockland over the age of 60. Programs and services such as case management, non-medical in-home services, home repair assistance for the disabled, and an energy assistance program are designed to help eligible seniors to maintain maximum independence in the home. Other programs provide employment, volunteer activities, education and socialization.

"This is a great milestone for June and the Office for Aging as both are celebrating a fortieth anniversary this year," said Legislator Paul. "June has spent a lifetime dedicating herself to our seniors and the programs that she oversees are critical to the well-being of Rockland's seniors. Credit must also go to the agency's staff members who, over the past forty years, have acted compassionately, in a knowledgeable and professional manner, for the benefit of our senior population. County government is very proud of the Office for Aging, its operations, its staff and of course, its dedicated director, June Molof."

Legislature Chairman Alden H. Wolfe added, "Congratulations to June Molof for forty years of excellence at the Office of the Aging. Ms. Molof has been a pioneer in blazing the trail toward innovative, top-notch programs for Rockland's older adults. She has been a valued partner in government. It has been my honor to collaborate with June Molof because she has the depth and breadth of institutional knowledge, which has enabled her to accomplish so much for Rockland's seniors."
