WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department of Mental Health (DMH) has advised the County Executive and the Legislature of Rockland County that the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) has awarded DMH a grant in the amount of \$3,920,269 for the period from September 30, 2016 through September 29, 2020; and

WHEREAS, The grant award requires a local share in the amount of \$1,938,246, which will include \$1,185,342 of in-kind services as well as \$752,904 in County-budgeted contractual services during the grant period; and

WHEREAS, \$331,795 of the grant award is and will be appropriated in the 2016 through 2020 adopted salaries and fringes of existing DMH positions providing SAMHSA services and, therefore, only \$3,588,474 of the grant award must be appropriated to DMH; and

WHEREAS, In accordance with the grant, DMH will work in partnership with the Department of Social Services, BOCES, the Probation Department and the District Attorney's Office to support the Partnership for Safe Youth Center and the broader Rockland County system of care to expand mental health and recovery support services for seriously emotionally disturbed youth ages 5 to 21 and their families; and

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WHEREAS, The goal of the grant is to provide broader services to youth and their families to support their health and mental health, increase high school graduations, reduce hospitalizations, lower foster care placements and lessen the number of youth involved with the juvenile and criminal justice system; and

WHEREAS, It is necessary to appropriate these funds to the proper accounts; and

WHEREAS, The Committee of the Legislature has met, considered and approved this resolution, now, therefore, be it
