WHEREAS, The County Executive and the Rockland County Legislature have been advised that the Office of the District Attorney has been awarded a continuation grant from the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services in the amount of \$108,950 for the Rockland County Re-Entry Task Force - Offender Re-Entry Program for the period October 1, 2016 through September 30, 2017; and

WHEREAS, This program is a collaboration between State and local criminal justice agencies, human services agencies, not-for-profit and private organizations, and governmental entities; and

WHEREAS, The goals of this program are as follows: (i) to help individuals returning from prison to the community to assess and address their criminogenic needs and provide linkages to services which will reduce their criminality and increase public safety; (ii) to coordinate a system of resources and services necessary to address criminogenic and stabilization needs of formerly incarcerated individuals; and (iii) to build support for re-entry as a public safety initiative through public education initiatives; and

WHEREAS, This continuation grant covers the cost of the Task Force Coordination performed by BRiDGES (Building Relationships, Investing in Diversity and Genuinely Empowering Self), formerly known as the Rockland Independent Living Center; and

WHEREAS, No County tax dollars (NCTD) are required to accept said grant; and

WHEREAS, It is necessary to appropriate these funds to the proper account; and

WHEREAS, Local Law No. 18 of 1996 provides for the Legislature to approve "execution of all contracts in excess of \$100,000 entered into by the County;" and

WHEREAS, The _____ Committee of the Legislature has met, considered and _____ approved this resolution, now, therefore, be it
