Winter Coat Drive Benefits Rockland Neighbors In Need Paul & Wolfe Partner With People To People For Successful Collection

New City, NY (Jan. 8, 2016) – About 50 coats have been donated as part of the Winter Coat Drive conducted by Legislators Aney Paul and Alden H. Wolfe in partnership with People to People.

Donations came from family, friends and the general public. They included new and gently-used coats for children and adults. Several sweaters and other warm clothing was also donated.

Diane Serratore, executive director of People to People, thanked Paul and Wolfe, as well as the Rockland County Legislature for the effort.

“People to People is Rockland County’s primary hunger relief organization but we do more than feed people,” Serratore said. “We try to make sure that kids are warm, adults are warm, in the winter. It’s nice to know our neighbors are helping people in need because it’s starting to get chilly out there and now more than ever, we need your help.”

Serratore picked up the coats today, with the help of agency Transportation Assistant Frank Vitaliano.

“I have seen many people who need help to keep them warm,” Paul said. “I want to thank everyone who donated and I want to thank People to People for helping our neighbors.”

Paul, who is Deputy Majority Leader, lives in Nanuet and represents District 14, which includes parts of Chestnut Ridge, Nanuet, Hillcrest and Spring Valley.

Wolfe, who has been elected Chairman of the Legislature for 2016, lives in Montebello and represents District 6, which includes part of Monsey, Montebello and Suffern.

“I’m happy to have partnered with Aney Paul and People to People for this coat drive,” Wolfe said. “There are so many people in our community who very quietly are suffering. This type of event, with the great success that we had, is so important to prove that Rockland takes care of its own.”
