Legislator Day said this was a continuation of a discussion to see how United Way's 2-1-1 system and InfoRock can distribute information during emergencies.

Claire Satenberg of United Way said that the 2-1-1 line provides information to the public about all types of services and assists during emergencies. There are multi-lingual specialists available, and information about numerous locations is available as well. There were over 26,000 calls during Hurricane Sandy, including 700 from Rockland.

Commissioner Sherwood complimented the work of 2-1-1.

Chair Cornell noted that the interactive feature on the website is very useful.
