Wolfe: Explore Harriman & Trail Town Corridor of Western Ramapo

Celebrating Harriman State Park & Communities of Suffern, Hillburn, Sloatsburg, Tuxedo

New City, NY (Feb. 22, 2016) – Rockland County Legislature Chairman Alden H. Wolfe encourages participation in this week’s Explore Harriman: Adventure in the Trail Town Corridor celebration.

“This is the latest impressive effort to familiarize people with the great opportunities that await them in Western Ramapo – everything from hiking, camping and fishing to terrific dining and rich cultural opportunities,” Wolfe said.

Wolfe has been working with the Suffern Chamber of Commerce and other enthusiasts to promote Western Ramapo’s outdoor activities and local downtowns and businesses, including new trail head signage in Suffern and efforts to attract New York City day trippers.

The “Trail Town” initiative refers to Harriman State Park, the villages of Suffern, Hillburn and Sloatsburg and the town of Tuxedo.

This week’s events will aid the continuing effort. On both Tuesday and Wednesday, the following activities are scheduled:

- The 13th Annual Banff Mountain Film Festival World Tour pulls into Suffern with a slew of film shorts on all kinds of outdoor adventures around the globe. Starts at 7 p.m. on both days, with films showing at the historic Lafayette Theater, 97 Lafayette Ave. in Suffern.
- The New York-New Jersey Trail Conference holds an open house at its beautiful new headquarters. Starts at 3 p.m. on both days at 600 Ramapo Valley Road in Mahwah, N.J. Great Gear Raffle tickets will be available, with prizes donated by Ramsey Outdoor.
- The Explore Harriman Trail Town Corridor Showcase at the Suffern Community Center. Starts at 5 p.m. both days at 41 Washington Ave., in Suffern. Meet exhibitors and purchase Harriman State Park maps. Raffle tickets will be available and the winners will be announced.
