PRESENTER: **SCOTT P. MOORE, ESQ.** – Legal specialist to and instructor for the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development’s Fair Housing Accessibility First Program. Mr. Moore represents clients in all fair housing and public accommodation matters. He is also a former senior trial attorney with the Housing and Civil Enforcement Section of the U.S. Department of Justice. While at the Justice Department, Mr. Moore served as lead counsel on some of the largest pattern or practice cases brought by the United States under the Fair Housing Act. Scott Moore is named in *The Best Lawyers in America 2011* and listed in the *2011 Great Plains Super Lawyers*.



Mr. Moore, recognized as a national expert in fair housing law and litigation, will present an educational session on Fair Housing. He will discuss the Fair Housing Laws impacting governmental agencies, discrimination claims common to governmental agencies (such as Common Interference Claims and Reasonable Accommodation Claims), and the False Claims Act. A question and answer period will be provided at the end of the presentation for participants to get answers to their questions.
