

6-Year Line Graph by Municipality

Figure 5 displays applications by municipality over the last six years. One can see that, while still the largest source of applications, referrals from Ramapo have declined for the past two years. On the other hand, Orangetown, the second largest source of application reviews, has increased steadily from each year from 2012. Consistently, the towns within Rockland County have had the highest number of submissions of General Municipal Law reviews, generally reflecting the larger land area of these municipalities. However, the Town of Haverstraw referred only seven applications this year, well below many village referrals, and the Town of Clarkstown had 45 development applications in 2016, a 66.7% increase from the previous year, but still below the previous 5-year average of 53.8 and the 34-year average of 92.7. In addition, five villages achieved their highest number of submissions in 2016: Kaser (18); New Square (10); Pomona (8); South Nyack (25); and Upper Nyack (24).
