APPROVING AN INTERMUNICIPAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF ROCKLAND
AND THE TOWN OF HAVERSTRAW POLICE DEPARTMENT
IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$60,000 (NCTD)
FOR THE PERIOD APRIL 1, 2014 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2015
IN ORDER FOR SAID TOWN TO PROVIDE AN EXPERIENCED
DOMESTIC VIOLENCE OFFICER IN CONNECTION WITH AN
ENHANCED DOMESTIC VIOLENCE PROSECUTION PROGRAM GRANT
THAT WAS PREVIOUSLY ACCEPTED BY RESOLUTION NO. 615 OF 2013
AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF THIS
AGREEMENT BY THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE

WHEREAS, Article 5-G of the General Municipal Law authorizes municipal governments to perform together that which each government is authorized to perform individually and requires that any intermunicipal cooperation agreement be approved by each participating municipal corporation by a majority vote of the voting strength of its governing body; and

WHEREAS, The County of Rockland, through its Office of the District Attorney, and the Town of Haverstraw Police Department desire to enter into an intermunicipal cooperation agreement in an amount not to exceed \$60,000 for the period April 1, 2014 through December 31, 2015 in order for said town to provide an experienced Domestic Violence Officer in connection with an Enhanced Domestic Violence Prosecution Program grant that was previously accepted by Resolution No. 615 of 2013; and

WHEREAS, No County tax dollars (NCTD) are required for this agreement since sufficient funding for this agreement exists within said grant (Dept. GA25, line E4090); and

WHEREAS, The Committees of the Legislature have met, considered and approved this resolution; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Legislature of Rockland County hereby approves an intermunicipal cooperation agreement between the County of Rockland, through its Office of the District Attorney, and the Town of Haverstraw Police Department in an amount not to exceed \$60,000 for the period April 1, 2014 through December 31, 2015 in order for said town to provide an experienced Domestic Violence Officer in connection with an Enhanced Domestic Violence Prosecution Program grant that was previously accepted by Resolution No. 615 of 2013, and authorizes the execution of this agreement by the County Executive, subject to the approval of the County Attorney; and be it further

RESOLVED, That no County tax dollars (NCTD) are required for this agreement since sufficient funding for this agreement exists within said grant (Dept. GA25, line E4090).
