The Rockland County Department of Health is currently seeking a candidate to perform professional nursing work of a complex nature involving the performance of a variety of public health nursing activities, including assessing nursing needs and implementing the plan of care for individuals and families plan of care development and implementation, counseling on health issues for patients and families in clinic and in-home settings. Work guidance (e.g. lead work) may be provided to paraprofessional and clerical staff.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

1. A Bachelor's degree or higher in Nursing from a regionally accredited or New York State registered (four-year) college or university and one (1) year of paid, professional nursing experience, performed under nursing supervision, in a state or federally licensed hospital, agency or institution and
2. Licensure and current registration to practice as a Registered Professional Nurse issued by the New York State Department of Education.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:

1. Licensure and current registration to practice as a Registered Professional Nurse issued by the New York State Department of Education must be maintained throughout the course of employment in this title.
2. Possession of a valid driver's license or accessibility to transportation to meet field work requirements in a timely and efficient manner.
